



## Killer Orca Whale

**Species:** Mammal **Average Life Span:** 50-80 years  
**Size:** 23-32 feet **Diet:** Carnivore  
**Fun Facts:** Whales are the largest member of the oceanic dolphin family. Orca or Killer whales hunt in groups of up to 40 whales, using cooperative hunting techniques.



## Humpback Whale

**Species:** Mammal **Average Life Span:** 45-50 years  
**Size:** 48-62.5 feet **Diet:** Omnivore  
**Fun Facts:** Humpback whales are known for their magical songs that travel great distances through the oceans. Each group of whales has a distinctive sound, like a song, that allows each whale to identify their pod.



## Dolphin

**Species:** Mammal **Average Life Span:** 45-50 years  
**Size:** 10-14 feet **Diet:** Carnivore  
**Fun Facts:** Dolphins communicate verbally, with squeaks and whistles; these sounds create echoes that help them to find their food underwater.



## Octopus

**Species:** Invertebrate **Average Life Span:** 2-15 years  
**Size:** 12-36 inches **Diet:** Carnivore  
**Fun Facts:** Octopi are highly intelligent animals and masters of camouflage, changing color and even texture to blend in with their surroundings and thereby avoid would-be attackers.



## Turtle

**Species:** Reptile **Average Life Span:** 50 years  
**Size:** 36 inches **Diet:** Carnivore  
**Fun Facts:** Sea turtles are slow moving on land, but they can move through the water at speeds of up to 15 miles per hour.



## Penguin

**Species:** Bird **Average Life Span:** 20 years  
**Size:** 1.2 m **Diet:** Carnivore  
**Fun Facts:** The emperor penguin is the largest of 17 species of penguin at 1.15 m tall.
